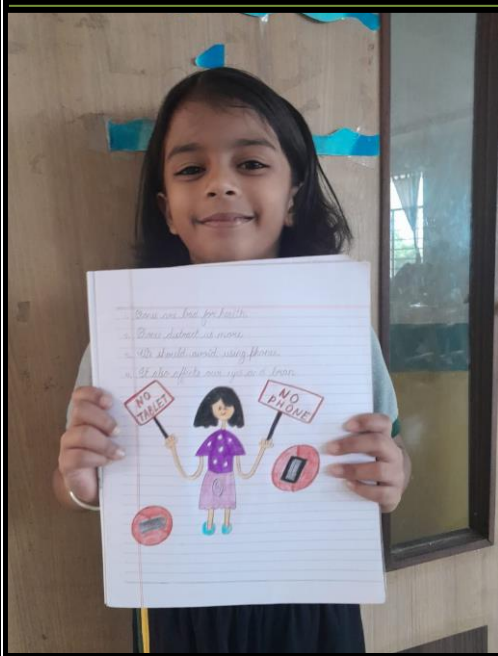


## STUDENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES
